Billing will follow a bi-monthly schedule. Bills are mailed on the 25th of every other month (even months) and will include the usage of the current month and the prior month. I understand that some customer have been paying \$40.00 per month and some have been paying \$50.00. Rates will be \$40.00 per month billed bi-monthly.

Please note, if you happen to see anything out of the ordinary that pertains to the water and distribution system, please give us a call so that we can look into it as soon as possible. Water leaks in the system affect us all. If you see any extra green areas in the grass, please let us know so can investigate the area for leakage. The cost to pump and provide quality drinking water is increasing, and that cost is shared by everyone. Saving water will help everyone.

Over the next several months, we will be digging up portions of the system to inspect the valves and piping. Some of the valves will need to be changed, while performing this work we plan on having very brief water interruptions. We will do our best to notify those affected customers in advance. The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has become more stringent with regards to water usage, therefore we will perform a leak study to ensure little to no water loss by leaking pipes in the distribution system.
